

Reformation


Reformation Day is October 31st every year. This day is celebrated in the Lutheran church and is the day we remember the work of Martin Luther and all the reformers and their contributions to the faith. The colour of the day is RED reminding us of the power of the Holy Spirit coming among God's people – much as in the Day of Pentecost.
