CONVERSATION QUESTIONS

The Account of Jesus' Ascension into heaven is recorded in Luke 24:50-53 and Acts 1:1-11. The following are some questions you may wish to discuss (in an age appropriate way):

- Have you ever had someone you care about move away? How did you feel?
 If someone does move away, do we stop being friends with them?
 Do you still keep in contact with them? If so, how?
- When Jesus 'ascended into heaven' the Bible says "a cloud hid Jesus from disciples".
 How do you think the disciples felt about Jesus leaving them?
 Why do you think it may be good for Jesus to physically leave them?
- Is Jesus in heaven since the Ascension, or is He in your heart?
 Where do you think He is?
 - Are there times when you feel abandoned by Jesus? When were they? When have you felt Jesus especially close to you?
- The Bible says that because Jesus ascended into heaven, He ruling as King.
 If Jesus is in heaven ruling, what does He rule over?
 If Jesus is King, what are some requests you for Him?
 Does Jesus hear every prayer?
- If Jesus is in heaven ruling, what do you think Jesus wants you to be doing until He comes back?
 - Jess said His disciples are to be His 'witnesses'. What do you think it means to be Jesus 'witnesses'?
 - How does knowing Jesus also gives us hope and joy?

APOSTLES' CREED

You may wish to say the following together as a family

I believe in God, the Father almighty, Maker of heaven and earth.

And in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord,
who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary,
suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, dead, and buried. He descended into hell.
The third day He rose again from the dead.
He ascended into heaven, and sits at the right hand of God, the Father almighty,
from thence He will come to judge the living and the dead.

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Christian church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen
