LORD God, loving heavenly Father:


You loved the world so much that You gave Your only Son to be our Saviour.

NICENE CREED

LORD God:

It is Your love that is revealed in the life and death of Jesus, it is Your power that is seen in His resurrection, and it is Your majesty that is made known by His ascension into heaven to be at Your side.

Help us, O God, to always keep Your power and Your authority and Your love and Your majesty in our minds, and to never neglect the doing of Your will.

You may wish to continue with the following as prayer points for today, and in the week ahead:

LORD God, loving Father: through You we live and move and have our being. And so we pray for:

- * all affected by the coronavirus COVID-19: the poor around the world who have no income; countries that have significant death tolls; those in authority that we are granted wisdom as lockdown restrictions are eased;
- * all schools and places of work transitioning to face-to-face interactions;
- * all who rule and govern that enact laws that care for all people, and that they seek to care for human life from conception through to old age;
- * all in need around the world, including those affected by war or disaster (including all affected by Cyclone Amphan across India and Bangladesh; locust plague in east Africa), and all refugees including Rohingya, Syria, Myanmar, South Sudan, Yemen);
- * all who are troubled and afraid that they may the presence of our loving God;
- * all who mourn the death of loved ones that hope and comfort is found in Christ Jesus;

LORD God, loving Jesus: You suffered for sins once for all, that You might bring us to God. And so we pray for:

- * the Church on earth that we would love Jesus and keep His word;
- * those who suffer for what is right, including those experience persecution for their faith in Jesus;
- * local Christian Congregations and ministries (including Chaplaincy in Schools, and welfare activities across the Peninsula that seek to minister to people in need);

LORD God, loving Spirit: You are our Companion and Helper. And so we pray for:

- * our 'Community of Grace', and for God's guiding and blessing on our life together;
- * all who rejoice in the birth of a child, or who are looking forward to the birth of a child;
- * all who rejoice in birthdays, baptism anniversaries, wedding anniversaries;
- * the those who are sick and desire healing, the housebound, and all in need in whatever way;

LORD God,

we praise and thank You for making us Your children,
not through our own power and piety
but through our baptism into crucified and risen Lord Jesus Christ.
Lead us to daily to You that we find peace, courage and purpose.
Make us as Your church to be a witness to our Risen and Ascended Lord;
For He lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever.
