PRAYER OF THE CHURCH

Jesus told His disciples: 'Go back and report to John what you hear and see. The blind receive sight, the lame walk, those who have leprosy are cured, the deaf hear, the dead are raised.' In the knowledge of the true healing Christ has brought into this world, let us pray for the world, the church, and our local needs.

We pray, saying: *LORD, in Your mercy, hear our prayer.*

In our prayers:

- peoples in lands of drought and desert that as Isaiah prophesied of water and joy, people may know relief and the joy that comes from true faith in Christ;
- * all farmers preparing for harvest, for safety and joy in this work, and a thankful heart to God for all His gifts;
- * the blind, lame, deaf, or suffering from any other disability, and all who help people with disabilities, that they know the strength and joy that comes from the Lord;
- * nations, and leaders of nations, that they strive for strong, respectful and trusting relationships in mixed-faith societies, that in spite of their religious differences and disagreements, people of different faiths can peacefully live and work together;
- * Christians suffering discrimination and persecution, especially in the Middle East and North Africa, the cradle of Christianity; as also Christians in Indonesia including the ethnic Chinese Christian Governor of Jakarta, Basuki 'Ahok' Tjahaja Purnama on 'blasphemy charges against Islam'; and that we always may respond with grace and love and thereby transform the hearts of those who seek to oppress Christianity;
- * all preparing for Christmas, that in the commercialism of our world the true message of Christ may heard, hearts would be led to true faith;
- * all preparing for holidays, that holy days may be kept, and people travel in safety;
- * the holy Church of God that we are patient, humbly reading and studying and praying God's Word;
- * all Church leaders including LCA Bishop John and LCAQD Bishop Paul, and all Pastors, that in the lead up to Christmas hearts are focused on Christ, and there is joy and strength and blessing in their work;
