PRAYER OF THE CHURCH

Jesus says to His followers: 'You are light for the world. Let your light shine before others.' As we rejoice in the light of God's love in Christ, let us pray for the world, the church, and all in need.

We pray, saying: *LORD, in Your mercy, hear our prayer.*

In our prayers:

- * thanksgiving to God for the gift of life He gives, and our land with its many blessings;
- * all in government (including Prime Minister, local MPs, and all in local government), that they may promote righteousness and peace, and seek to protect life from conception to old age;
- * places of war and terror that they may know peace and true reconciliation;
- * refugees seeking peace, including converts to Christianity in Germany, and all who are persecuted for their confession of Jesus as Lord;
- * those divided by enmity and hatred, that by love and forgiveness broken relationships might be restored
- * families that are divided or alienated from one another that they may true reconciliation
- * all who have experienced disaster (including fires in NSW and elsewhere), and for rain in dry places where need;

- * thanksgiving to God in Christ for the true forgiveness and reconciliation we have in Christ;
- * the church, that together we are a sign of forgiveness in the world;
- * the Lutheran Church of Australia, that as we prepare for the 500th anniversary of 'The Reformation' our desire is to remain true to God's Word as we witness to God's reconciling love in Christ;
