<u>APPLYING FOR A BLUE CARD</u> You need to hold a blue card when working with children. Forms are available in the narthex or from the website. Please bring the completed form into the church office along with the required ID. Photocopies are not acceptable as the ID MUST be sighted by Elke. Forms are also available on our website. If your card is due to expire, allow yourself sufficient time for renewal. You are NOT eligible to work with children without a Blue Card or with an expired Blue Card.

<u>EXEMPTION CARD APPLICATION</u> In addition to your work as a registered teacher you can only provide other child-related services either in a volunteer, paid or self-employed capacity by applying for an exemption card. Please complete an Exemption card application (E) form. There is no fee to apply for an exemption card. Generally, exemption card applicants can commence in child-related work as soon as an exemption application is lodged with Blue Card Services.

<u>LINK AN APPLICANT/CARDHOLDER TO THIS ORGANISATION</u> This form is to be completed by applicants/cardholders who have applied for, or hold a blue/exemption card to advise they are undertaking child-related activities with a new or additional organisation. Please indicate the type of child-related activity for the new or additional organisation: Volunteer (no payment required) Student (no payment required) Paid employee (payment required if currently holding a V card).
