THE CANDLES OF ADVENT THE FOURTH SUNDAY OF ADVENT: LOVE

Today is the fourth Sunday of Advent The fourth candle of Advent is the Candle of Love. Its light is meant to remind us of the love that God has for us.

Jesus shows us God's perfect love. He is God's love in human form. The bible says that "God so loved the world that He gave His only Son, so that whoever believes in Him should not perish, but have eternal life."

He sets aside the first to establish the second. ¹⁰And by that will, we have been made holy through the sacrifice of the body of Jesus Christ once for all.

³⁹ In those days Mary arose and quickly went into the hill country, to a city of Judah, ⁴⁰ and entered the house of Zechariah and greeted Elizabeth. ⁴¹ When Elizabeth heard the greeting of Mary, the baby leaped in her womb. And Elizabeth was filled with the Holy Spirit. ⁴² She spoke out with a loud voice, "Blessed are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of your womb! ⁴³ But why is this granted to me, that the mother of my Lord should come to me? ⁴⁴ Indeed, as soon as the sound of your greeting came to my ears, the baby in my womb leaped for joy. ⁴⁵ Blessed is she who believed, for there will be a completion to those things which were told her by the Lord."

NICENE CREED
