**FIRST READING:** Acts 11:1-18 Peter explains how God's salvation is also for Gentiles (ISV)

<sup>1</sup> Now the apostles and the brothers and sisters who were in Judea heard that the gentiles had also accepted the Word of God. <sup>2</sup> But when Peter went up to Jerusalem, those who emphasised circumcision disagreed with him. <sup>3</sup>They said, "You went to uncircumcised men and ate with them!" <sup>4</sup>Then Peter began to explain to them point by point what had happened. He said, <sup>5</sup> "I was in the town of Joppa praying when in a trance I saw a vision: Something like a large linen sheet descended down from heaven, lowered by its four corners, and it came right down to me. <sup>6</sup> When I examined it closely, I saw four-footed animals of the earth, wild animals, reptiles, and birds of the air. <sup>7</sup> I also heard a voice telling me, 'Get up, Peter! Kill something and eat it.' 8 But I replied, 'Absolutely not, Lord, for nothing common or unclean has ever entered my mouth!' <sup>9</sup>Then the voice from heaven answered a second time, 'You must stop calling common what God has made clean!' 10 This happened three times. Then everything was pulled back <sup>11</sup> "At that very moment three men arrived at the house up to heaven. where we were staying. They had been sent to me from Caesarea. 12 The Spirit told me to go with them without hesitating. These six brothers went with me, too, and we entered the house of the man from Caesarea. 13 Then he told us how he had seen an angel standing in his home and saying, 'Send messengers to Joppa and summon Simon, who is called Peter. 14 He will discuss with you how you and your entire household will be saved.' <sup>15</sup> "When I began to speak, the Holy Spirit fell on them just as He was first given to us. 16 Then I remembered what the Lord had said: 'John baptised with water, but you will be baptised with the Holy Spirit.' 17 Now if God gave them the same gift that He gave us when we believed in the Lord Jesus, the Messiah, who was I to try to stop God?" <sup>18</sup> When they heard this, they calmed down, and praised God by saying, "So God has given repentance that leads to life even to gentiles."

## PSALM: Psalm 148 (NKJV)

<sup>1</sup> Praise the LORD! Praise the LORD from the heavens; praise Him in the heights! <sup>2</sup> Praise Him, all His angels; praise Him, all His hosts! <sup>3</sup> Praise Him, sun and moon; praise Him, all you stars of light! <sup>4</sup> Praise Him, you heavens of heavens, and you waters above the heavens! <sup>5</sup> Let them praise the name

of the LORD, For He commanded and they were created. <sup>6</sup> He also established them forever and ever; He made a decree which shall not pass away. <sup>7</sup> Praise the LORD from the earth, you great sea creatures and all the depths; <sup>8</sup> fire and hail, snow and clouds; stormy wind, fulfilling His word; <sup>9</sup> mountains and all hills; fruitful trees and all cedars; <sup>10</sup> Beasts and all cattle; creeping things and flying birds; <sup>11</sup> Kings of the earth and all peoples; princes and all judges of the earth; <sup>12</sup> both young men and maidens; old men and children. <sup>13</sup> Let them praise the name of the LORD, for His name alone is exalted; His glory is above the earth and heaven. <sup>14</sup> And He has exalted the dominion of His people, the praise of all His saints— of the children of Israel, a people near to Him. Praise the LORD!

**SECOND READING:** Revelation 21:1-6 God will wipe away all tears *(NIV)* <sup>1</sup> Then I saw 'a new heaven and a new earth,' for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away, and there was no longer any sea. <sup>2</sup> I saw the Holy City, the new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride beautifully dressed for her husband. <sup>3</sup> And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, 'Look! God's dwelling-place is now among the people, and He will dwell with them. They will be His people, and God Himself will be with them and be their God. <sup>4</sup> "He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death" or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away.' <sup>5</sup> He who was seated on the throne said, 'I am making everything new!' Then He said, 'Write this down, for these words are trustworthy and true.' <sup>6</sup> He said to me: 'It is done. I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End. To the thirsty I will give water without cost from the spring of the water of life.

**GOSPEL:** John 13:31-35 The new commandment: love one another *(NKJV)* <sup>31</sup> So, when he [Judas] had gone out, Jesus said, "Now the Son of Man is glorified, and God is glorified in Him. <sup>32</sup> If God is glorified in Him, God will also glorify Him in Himself, and glorify Him immediately. <sup>33</sup> Little children, I shall be with you a little while longer. You will seek Me; and as I said to the Jews, 'Where I am going, you cannot come,' so now I say to you. <sup>34</sup> A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another. <sup>35</sup> By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another."
