FIRST READING: Proverbs 8:1-4, 22-31 Wisdom's role in creation (NIVUK)

⁸ Does not wisdom call out? Does not understanding raise her voice? ² At the highest point along the way, where the paths meet, she takes her stand; ³ beside the gate leading into the city, at the entrance, she cries aloud: ⁴ 'To you, O people, I call out; I raise my voice to all humanity. ²² 'The LORD brought me forth as the first of his works, ^{[a][b]} before his deeds of old; ²³ I was formed long ages ago, at the very beginning, when the world came to be. ²⁴ When there were no watery depths, I was given birth, when there were no springs overflowing with water; ²⁵ before the mountains were settled in place, before the hills, I was given birth, ²⁶ before he made the world or its fields or any of the dust of the earth. ²⁷ I was there when

he set the heavens in place, when he marked out the horizon on the face of the deep,²⁸ when he established the clouds above and fixed securely the fountains of the deep,²⁹ when he gave the sea its boundary so that the waters would not overstep his command, and when he marked out the foundations of the earth.³⁰ Then I was constantly^[c] at his side. I was filled with delight day after day, rejoicing always in his presence,³¹ rejoicing in his whole world and delighting in the human race.
